

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL (SPEED LIMIT ORDER) (EXPERIMENTAL) (A338 WESSEX WAY) (VARIATION NO.1) ORDER 2010

Bournemouth Borough Council, <u>has made</u> the above Order on 7 January 2010. When the Order becomes operative on 21 January 2010 the restrictions listed in the Schedule to this notice will apply.

The provisions of the Schedule may be varied or amended within the regulations governing Experimental Orders. The persons authorised to agree such variations or amendments are: The Chief Constable of the Dorset Police and The Director of Planning & Transport Services of the Bournemouth Borough Council; or such of their officers as they may authorise.

A copy of the Order as made, maps showing the location and effects of the Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for proceeding by way of an experimental order and its intention to consider making a permanent order in like terms; may be examined at the Enquiry Desk at the Town Hall Annexe, Bournemouth on Mondays to Thursdays between 9.00am and 4.30pm, and on Fridays between 9.00am and 4.00pm.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 8 January 2010, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order - 21 January 2010, or if the Order is subsequently varied by other Orders under section 9 of the Act or modified pursuant to sub-section (2) of Section 10 of the Act, from the coming into operation of those variations or modifications (whichever are the latest), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation. Any such objection must be in writing, must give the grounds on which it is made and must be addressed to the undersigned.
