As an inducement to **Sauk County** to issue a Land Use Permit (_____) for the above described property, we agree to the following:

1. Owner(s) agree to conform to the attached Treated Impervious Surface-Licensed Engineer designed system which was submitted as part of the Land Use Permit. If the system proposed in this plan is not installed and maintained as proposed, Sauk County does have the right to revoke said permit and require removal of the structures authorized by said permit.
2. Owner(s) agree that removal of the structures authorized by this Land Use Permit will not void this agreement.
3. Owner(s) agree that the Treated Impervious Surface system specified in the attached plan shall be installed and shall remain and be preserved upon this property in perpetuity.
4. Owner(s) agree to allow authorized representatives of the Sauk County Conservation, Planning and Zoning Department to enter upon the owner's property described above to inspect the structure(s) authorized by this permit and to determine if the agreed upon Treated Impervious Surface system listed in the attached mitigation plan have been met.
5. The owner(s) agree to submit this affidavit and attached Treated Impervious Surface system plan and the required recording fee to the Sauk County Conservation, Planning and Zoning Department, and agree to record this agreement with the Register of Deeds in a manner which will notify any individual referencing the deed to the property as to the existence of this agreement.
6. The owner(s) agree that the attached Treated Impervious Surface system plan has been approved as part of the Land Use Permit.
7. All heirs and assigns of this property are bound and obligated to maintain the Treated Impervious Surface-Licensed Engineer designed per the agreed upon plan.
8. This agreement may be released by the Sauk County Conservation, Planning, and Zoning Department if the property becomes compliant with the impervious surface standards of the Sauk County Shoreland Protection Ordinance.
9. This agreement shall be binding upon the owner(s), their heirs, successors and assigns.
