#### **GARRY CONNELLY**



Garry was instrumental in bringing the World Rally Championship to Australia in 1988 and served as Chairman of the Organising Committee, Board member and Clerk of Course of Rally Australia until December 2002. He has been an FIA Steward and FIA Observer since 1989, covering the FIA WRC, the FIA WTCC and the FIA Formula One World Championship. He is Chairman of the Australian Institute of Motor Sport Safety and director of the Australian Road Safety Foundation. He is a member of the FIA World Motor Sport Council, a member of the FIA Scientific Advisory Committee and FIA Environmental Delegate.

#### SILVIA BELLOT FIA WOMEN IN MOTORSPORT AMBASSADOR; FORMULA 1, FORMULA E, FORMULA 2 AND FORMULA 3 STEWARD

Silvia Bellot began marshalling in 2001, aged 16, and has been a steward in a number of championships including: WRC, WTCC, F3 World Cup, GP2, GP3, DTM, Euro Formula and World Series. She made her first appearance as an F1 steward in 2011 and a year later was awarded FIA Outstanding Official. In 2018 she combined her duties as an F1 steward with the role of Team Manager for an INDYCAR team. In 2020 she became the first FIA female race director, in the FIA Formula 2 and Formula 3 Championships. She is currently an Ambassador of the FIA Women in Motorsport Commission, representing female volunteers and officials.

# FORMER FORMULA 1 DRIVER, CHAMP CAR, INDYCAR, WEC AND FIA GT1 DRIVER

Brazilian driver Enrique Bernoldi had a stellar junior career, winning the Formula Renault Europe title in 1996, before twice finishing on the podium in Macau, and runner-up in the 1998 British F3 Championship. He combined F3000 with a stint as a Sauber test driver in 1999 and 2000, before making his F1 debut with Arrows in 2001. He made 29 appearances for Arrows over the next season and a half, with a best result of eighth. He followed this with spells as a test driver for BAR and Honda, then moved on to US open-wheel racing, Brazilian stock cars and sportscars.

### DENNIS DEAN NATIONAL STEWARD

Dennis Dean has been involved in motor sport since becoming a scrutineer with the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) in the late 1970s. He has served at national level as a scrutineer, steward, and race director, including 10 years as either assistant chief steward or chief steward (race director) of the SCCA's National Championship Runoffs. He has scrutineered at 10 US Formula One races, in Las Vegas, Indianapolis and Austin. He was also vice president of Club Racing and Rally/Solo for SCCA. He currently serves as a member of both the FIA's International Sporting Code Review Commission.
